UPLOAD VIDEO OR PHOTOS FROM CAMERA USING APPLE CAMERA CONNECTION KIT TO IPAD THEN TO YOUR DROPBOX



IMPORT PHOTOS AND VIDEOS FROM YOUR DIGITAL CAMERA USING THE APPLE IPAD CAMERA CONNECTION KIT

The iPad Camera Connection Kit includes two adapters

A Camera Connector for importing photos and video from a USB camera or iPhone and an SD Card Reader for importing photos and video from a memory card.

To Import Photos from a Camera or iPhone:

1. Turn on iPad and attach the **Camera Connector** to the dock connector port
2. Turn on your camera or iPhone and connect it to the Camera Connector using the USB cable that came with your camera or iPhone.
3. On iPad, select the photos and videos that you want to Import.




To import photos from an SD card:

1. Insert a memory card that contains photos or videos into the **SD Card Reader**.
2. Turn on iPad and attache the **SD Card Reader** to the dock connector port.
3. On iPad, select the photos and videos that you want to Import.




UPLOAD TO YOUR DROPBOX USING DROPBOX IPAD APP

1. Open the Dropbox App, link to account etc.
2. Click the Box icon on the left hand side, a pop up opens




3. Click the uploads tab at the bottom, which is immediately next to the settings



4. Click the "+" at the top of the uploads section
The app still asks for permission to access your locations, (because photos can contain location data)

5. Tap the photos and videos you want to send to Dropbox from the resulting photo gallery.
* Choose a location to upload your photos and videos
* You can browse your Dropbox for an upload destination or create a new folder.
When you've found your location, tap Choose

6. Once done select 'Upload'

Optional:
The title of the button at the bottom of the menu indicates where the files will be uploaded.

5. **Tap** the photos and videos you want to send to Dropbox from the resulting photo gallery.

Optional: The Title of the button at the bottom of the menu indicates where the files will be uploaded. Tap the button to designate a new destination folder.

* Choose a location to upload your photos and videos

* You can browse your Dropbox for an upload destination or create a new folder.


When you've found your location, tap the Choose button at the bottom of the menu

6. Once done select '**Upload**' button at the top of the screen

7. You will then see a progress bar as the photos upload

7. You will then see a **progress bar** as the **photos upload**

8. Wait until all the photos have **finished Uploading**.

9. A large upload will continue to transfer for a short period of time even after you have exited the Dropbox app.
